In September 2008, AGC was awarded a contract by Saipem to supply Offshore Manning for the pipelay and installation of the Blacktip Wellhead Platform and Jacket, located approximately 245km south west of Darwin in the Bonaparte Basin, Australia at a water depth of 50m.

Saipem was awarded the EPIC contract for the Blacktip Development Project which included the installation and pre-commissioning of the wellhead platform and the 108km export pipeline system. Saipem's installation vessel Castoro Otto was

utilised for the marine activities.

AGC's scope of work included supply of management and offshore manning for the pipelay and installation of the Wellhead Platform and Jacket on Saipem's vessel Castoro Otto.

After sail away of the Castoro Otto, AGC's contract was extended to include manning for the hook-up and pre-commissioning activities on the Ocean Shields (drilling rig).

Other services performed included welder qualifications, HSE training



and provision of accommodation in Darwin and logistics.

The project was completed on 16 September 2009.
